I would have preferred that the directive had been adopted. On the balance, while progress was made, we would have preferred to have made much more progress. I am one of those ...

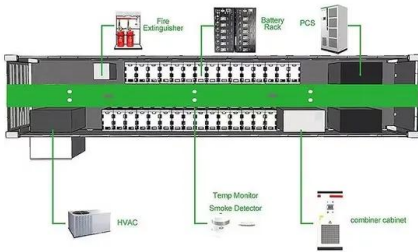
If you prefer/preferred, I'd be happy to pick you up

I wouldn't say "I preferred to stay at home to watch TV" because I don't like repeating 'to' with different meanings -- the first being the infinitive 'to' and the equivalent to "in order to", ...

Because, from the point of view of the speaker, he is referring to a past action (being given tea), albeit recent, so the past perfect tense is used. So, the full meaning is "I would have ...
